




NORTH STAR CRAFT




Fold an 8.5 x 11 sheet of paper in half.




Fold the paper in half again then unfold this step.




With the fold at the top, take the top right corner and match it to the halfway point along the left side. Hold these points together, flatten the craft, and fold the paper down.




Take the top left corner, lay it over the top of the craft, and fold the craft along the edge of the upper layer.




Fold the upper left edge over to match the upper right edge.



Turn the craft over.




Using scissors cut diagonally from the lower left (above the point) to the upper right (2 inches from the top).




Unfold the star.


POLAR BEAR CRAFT




Fold $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 11 paper in half then unfold.




Fold diagonally so that the bottom edge matches the right edge. Then unfold again.





Fold diagonally so that the bottom edge matches the left edge. Then unfold again.




Turn paper over and fold the bottom half up, with the fold line at the center of where the other fold lines cross. Then unfold again.




Turn paper back over. Bring the sides at point A together. The other folds will collapse bringing corners B and C down to their matching points on the side.




Turn the craft over and fold the top flap over matching side D to the center fold.




Do the same thing with the flap on the left matching side E to the center.




Turn the craft over and fold the right side to the left on the existing fold line.




Then fold the top flap over, matching side F with the center.




Fold the top flap up diagonally at the lower left point and so that side G is horizontal.




Fold the top flap to the right using the center fold.




Fold the left flap to the right and fold side H to the center.




Fold the bottom point of the flap to match the fold you made on the other flap.




Fold the top flap to the left using the center fold.




Fold the outer points in about a third of an inch. Match the top edges when folding. These are the feet.




Fold the bottom section up. Matching points I and J as shown.




Fold the tip down about half an inch.



Fold the craft down the center.



Now you can see the polar bear shape.



To keep the bear from collapsing you'll need to make folds to the rear legs underneath the bear. This is tricky, but be patient. Fold one small fold, then fold another small one in the same direction.
